1st Grade Non-Negotiable English Word Program

General Guidelines – Teacher use only.

- **1.)** Words reviewed orally or by writing with students beginning each Monday by classroom teacher. Teacher pronounces each word and uses the word in a sentence. Students practice the words orally or by writing (recommended) with teacher. Teacher can ask students to spell words on white boards or on the backs of their papers at transition times or short periods of class time when lesson finishes early each day. It should be noted that this program should NOT take the place of a structured phonics program or of word family learning (e.g. fat, rat, cat, mat, sat). It is a program designed to ensure children can spell the most common words that are age appropriate for 1st grade and it leads into the 2nd through 6th Grade 800 Non-Negotiable English Word Program.
- **2.)** Children practice with weekly practice guide sheets, more than once if necessary. Teacher provides example of what "quality of work" is accepted in his/her classroom. Teacher should check the sheet for neatness and completeness by Wednesday. Teacher should tell students to say the word quietly aloud to themselves and think about the word as they write the each word five times on weekly practice sheets. Students should practice by writing each word horizontally before moving onto the next word. Horizontal practice on sheet <u>only</u> is highly recommended for each word not vertically! Also, students should write a basic sentence under each word they have practiced (5 times) on the line that is provided so they are able to readily apply meaning in context.
- **3.)** Test is scheduled for Friday at 2:15 PM (or of the teacher's choosing) via TV for all 1st grade classrooms at one time, if possible. Principal, teacher or representative administers test. Teachers closely monitor students in the classroom during the test. Any words that are missed during test, teacher will repeat those words at the end of the broadcast (if closed circuit broadcast is used) prior to checking.
- **4.)** Answer document/test papers are exchanged or each student may score their own paper as teacher closely monitors. Any student not scoring at least 4 out of 5 words correctly must repeat the practice exercise or specific words they missed from that word list the following week. Teachers are encouraged to have weekly word poster lists of words in classroom for easy view of students during the week, but covered during weekly test.
- **5.)** Reward system is governed by teacher preference or classroom vote. A letter grade entered in the gradebook is at the discretion of the teacher, but these are common words in the English language and should be known whether a grade is given or not.
- **6.)** Students who do not do well on a weekly test MUST complete that sheet (or specific words incorrectly spelled) again the next week along with the new week's 5 word assignment. Extra homework is also recommended during that next week to ensure the student(s) has (have) sufficient practice to perform well on that week's Friday test to avoid poor performance in consecutive weeks.
- **7.)** An Excel spreadsheet with each student's name in each classroom may be kept with a record of the student passing and/or not passing for accountability purposes and remediation, as needed. Color coding of red/green based on passing or not passing on the sheet provides an easy reference for parent-teacher conferences.
- **8.**) It is highly recommended that at the start of the school year the weekly practice sheets in this program be bound with a spiral binding with the exception of the teacher guidelines on this page and the answer document. The binding into one book allows the teacher to facilitate efficiency in the program's classroom use as well as provide easy student reference during class writing exercises and activities.
